We enjoyed exploring measures in maths and getting our hands messy.

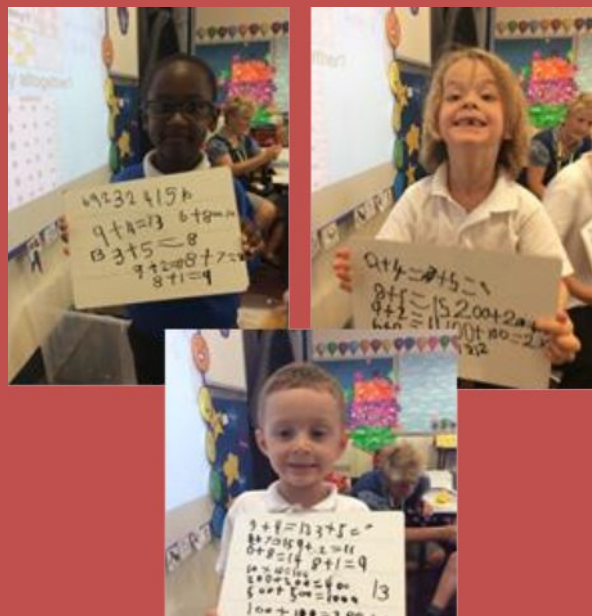


We enjoyed collaging our Funny Bones Setting.
