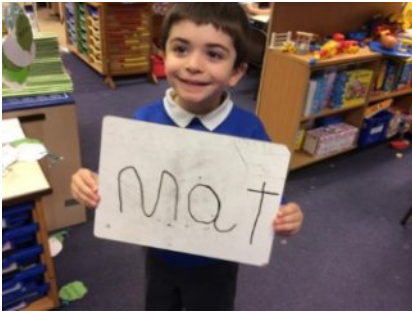

This term we have also been very busy with our Phonics and Maths sessions. In Phonics we have already completed Phase 2 of Letters and Sounds and have been very keen to use this new knowledge in our independent reading and writing. In Numeracy sessions we have been singing lots of number rhymes and counting. We have predominantly focussed on recognising and ordering numbers to ten and have used the Numicon to support this. We have also been learning about 2d and 3d shapes, which we just keep spotting everywhere!



At this point in the term we are incredibly excited about the festive season and have begun practising for our Christmas performance. We look forward to performing it to you all!
