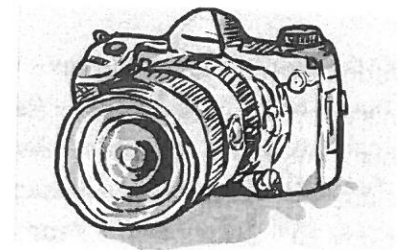
New Approach to Reading in KS1

We are hoping for a spot-tacular day!



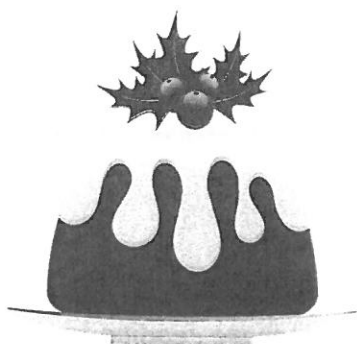
Open Evening in Reception
