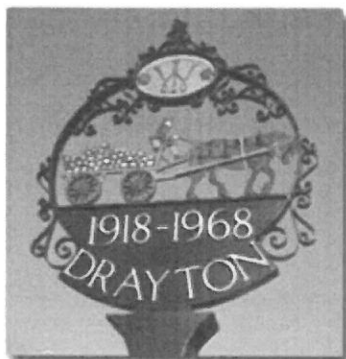

## **Florence Carter Memorial Park Refurbishment**

The Florence Carter Memorial Park on School Road is to shortly undertake a major upgrade of the facilities. This upgrade will involve removing and replacing the majority of the existing play equipment. In addition, the opportunity to add additional play equipment will also be taken, as well as installing a 1 metre high bow top fence around the perimeter with access gates.

The work is scheduled to start week commencing 17th June 2019 and the works will necessitate the closure of the service road (layby) which runs in front of the park, along School Road. The works are expected to take 3 or 3 weeks depending on the weather conditions. School Road itself and Pond Lane will remain open at all times.
