Dear Parent/Carer,

Sports Day this year is on Thursday 11th July 2019.

Year 1 and 2 children are having a 'Quad kids' Athletic Sports' Morning from 9.15am – 11.40am. It covers the core disciplines of running, jumping and throwing, which the children have been learning in their PE lessons throughout the year. It is a recognised pathway into Athletics competition, designed with enjoyment in mind.

There will be 6 team activities and each class will start at a different activity and work their way round the field until they have completed all 6 activities. Once you have dropped your child off as usual in the morning please make your way onto the school field. Teachers will bring their classes out onto the field when the registers have been completed. Please feel free to follow your child around as they complete each activity. They will then go back to their class at 10.30 for a quick toilet break; drink and snack for 15 minutes. If your child needs to go to the toilet during the activities, a member of staff will accompany them into school for safeguarding reasons. After that each class will have relay races outside on the straight track in their teams. Parents then can say well done and goodbye to their children before they go back to class. Mrs Winter will stand at the gate at the beginning and the end of the event to welcome parents and say goodbye at the end.

All children, EYFS, Year 1 and Year 2 will then have a Sports Day picnic outside with their class teachers and an opportunity to play and relax.

Parents of Reception children are welcomed to come for the EYFS Sports Afternoon starting at 1.30pm. We will open the main gate at 1.15pm to allow time for parents to make their way onto the school field where the activities will be taking place. Once this is finished the children will go back to their classroom with their class teacher. You may collect your child from their classroom and their siblings. School will finish at the usual time of 3pm for the remainder of Years 1 and 2.

Children can come to school in their PE kits of white T-shirt, black shorts and sturdy, comfortable trainers. Please ensure that they have a sunhat, full bottle of water and sun-cream on. It would be great to see as many parents, grandparents, as well as other family members, to watch your child in his/her Sports.

In the event of poor weather the alternative sports day is Thursday 18th July. We will text parents as soon as possible to let you know if we decide to rearrange this event. Please can we ask you to ensure that younger siblings are with you at all times in order to ensure that the children can really enjoy this event without interruption.

I look forward to seeing you on the 11th July for what I am sure is going to be a great celebration of Drayton Infant Schools' sporting ability!
